- \$14,300 beginning of school year - \$14,300
- Durins school year:
  - \$12,500 deposits
  - \$22,200 expenses of 22200, net \$9,700 expenditures out.
- Dues and donations
- 408 members, \$7,200 in dues and donations
- \$4,800 in donations for staff appreciation campaign
- Funded \$5,800 in classroom teacher grants
- \$5,300 beautification committee
- \$5,600 staff appreciation events
- \$3,000 Wheeler fencing club equipment, etc.
- \$4,600 available funds at end of year
  - Will be transferred over for next school year
